## Horticulture Fair - Totagarike Mela 2016



University of Horticultural Sciences, Bagalkot organized fifth *Totagarike Mela* (Horticulture Fair) from 17-19<sup>th</sup> December, 2016 at Bagalkot in collaboration with NABARD, Karnataka Vikas Grameena Bank, NHM, NHB, Karnataka State Mango Development and Marketing Corporation Ltd. Bagalkot District Credit Cooperative Bank, Bagalkot, Arsta Eco, Australia, Sarala Jeevan, JISL Pvt. Ltd. Karnataka Wine Board, Indo American Hybrid Seeds Pvt. Ltd. Bengaluru, Department of Horticulture, Agriculture and other Developmental Departments of Govt. of Karnataka. *Totagarike Mela 2016* had the main theme of '**Horticulture for Inclusive Income Growth**' was inaugurated by Smt. Veena V. Kashappanavar, President, Zilla Panchayat, Bagalkot on 17.12.2016 in presence of Sri G. S. Patil, MLA, Ron, Sri Basavaraj Neelappa Shivannavar, MLC, Sri R. Kashappanavar called upon the famers to make use of the technologies and inputs made available at single platform. She released the revised edition of Package of Practices on Horticultural crops & UHS Calendar-2017.



Technical sessions on “Management of water resources in Horticulture crop” and “Horticulture for Inclusive Income Growth” involving progressive farmers and the scientists were held on the first day afternoon.
